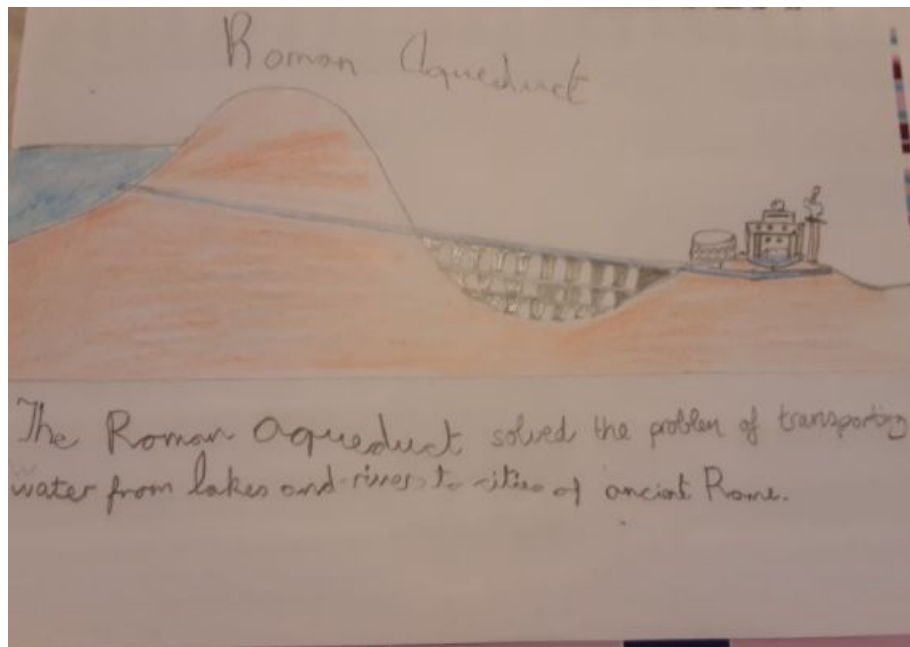
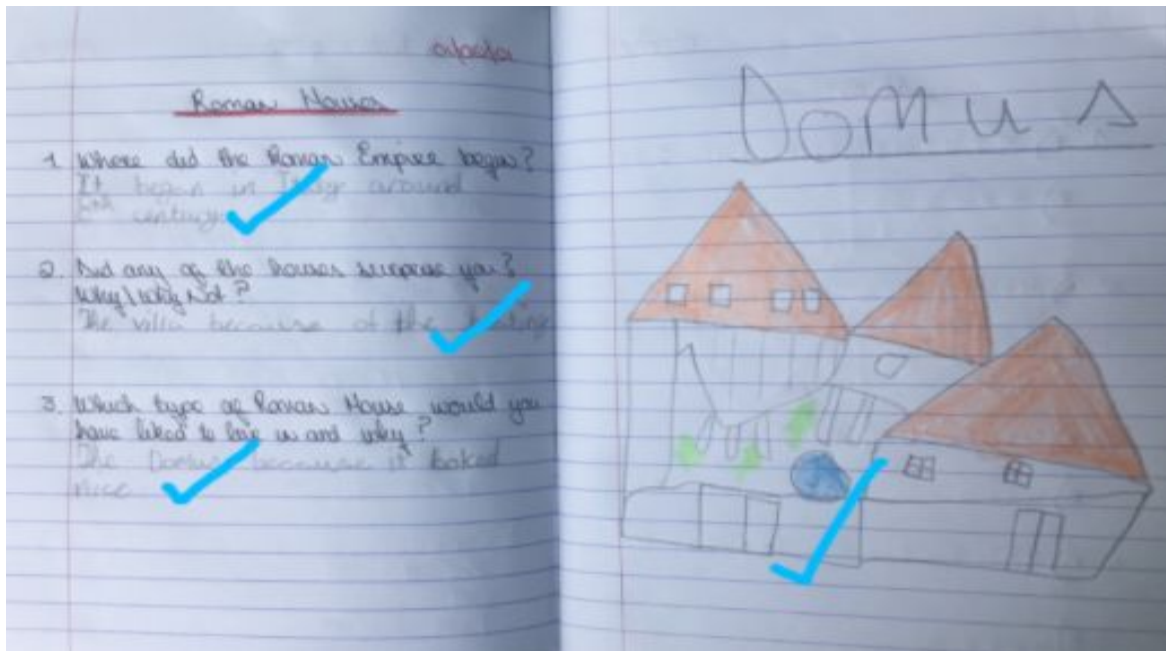
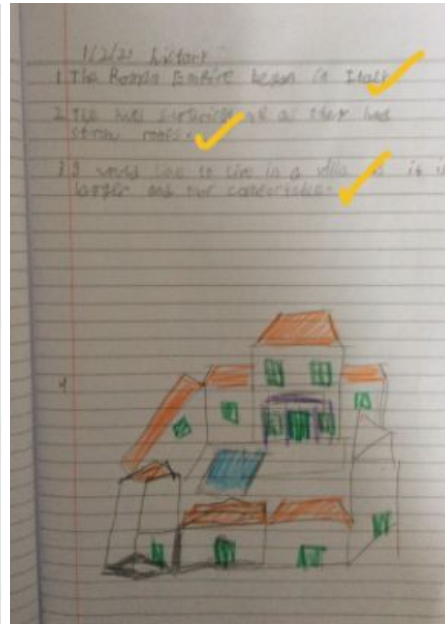


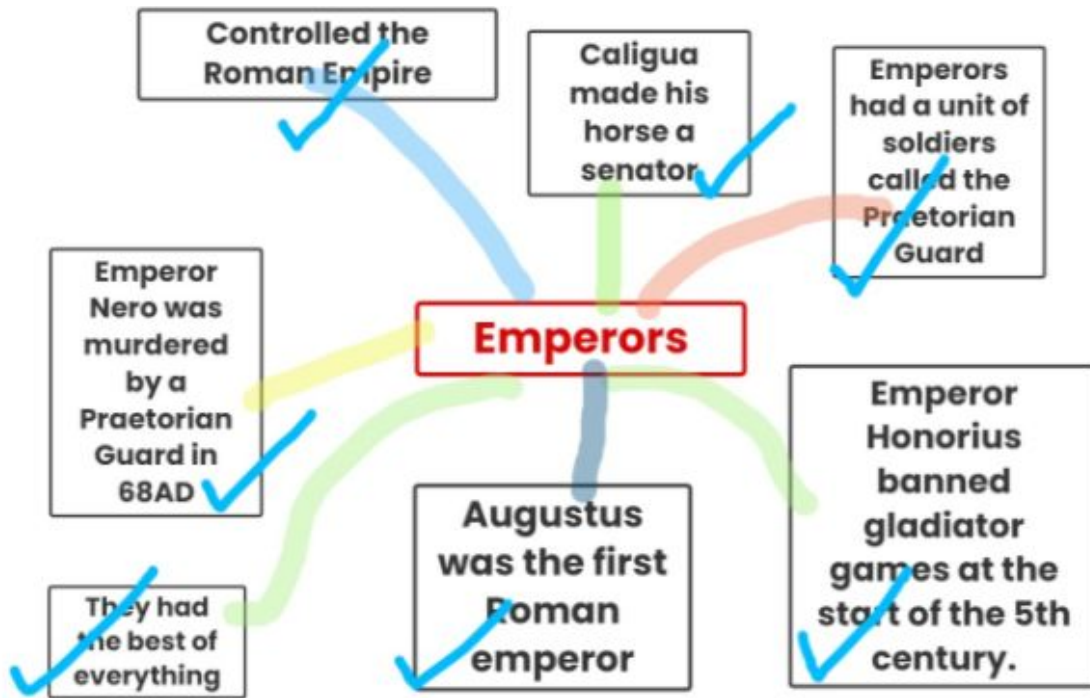
## 3<sup>rd</sup> Class Lockdown Learning

3rd Class boys have been learning all about the Romans and Roman Society. They learned all about what the Romans ate and drank and the different types of buildings where they lived. The boys also researched their own areas of interest. Some of the boys decided to investigate the Colosseum and the gladiators that used to fight there, some boys decided to learn about Roman emperors and other boys decided to learn more about Roman aqueducts.

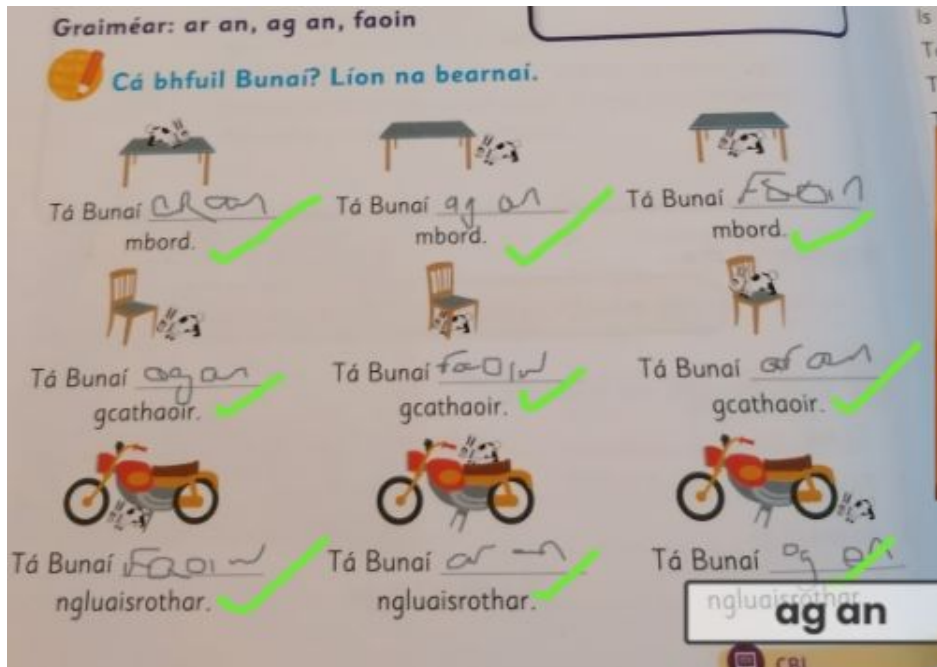
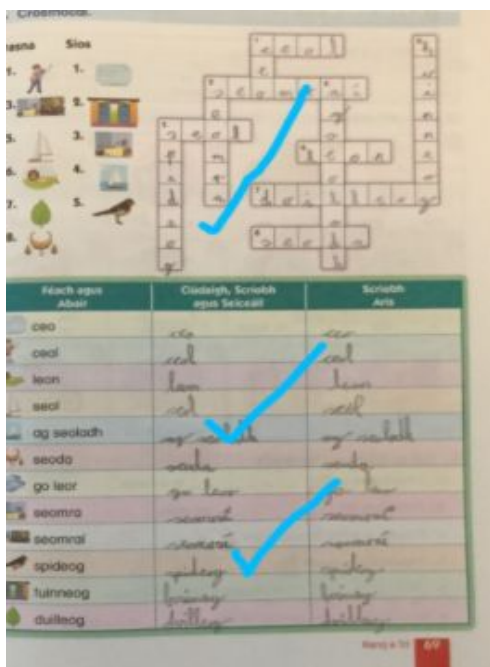

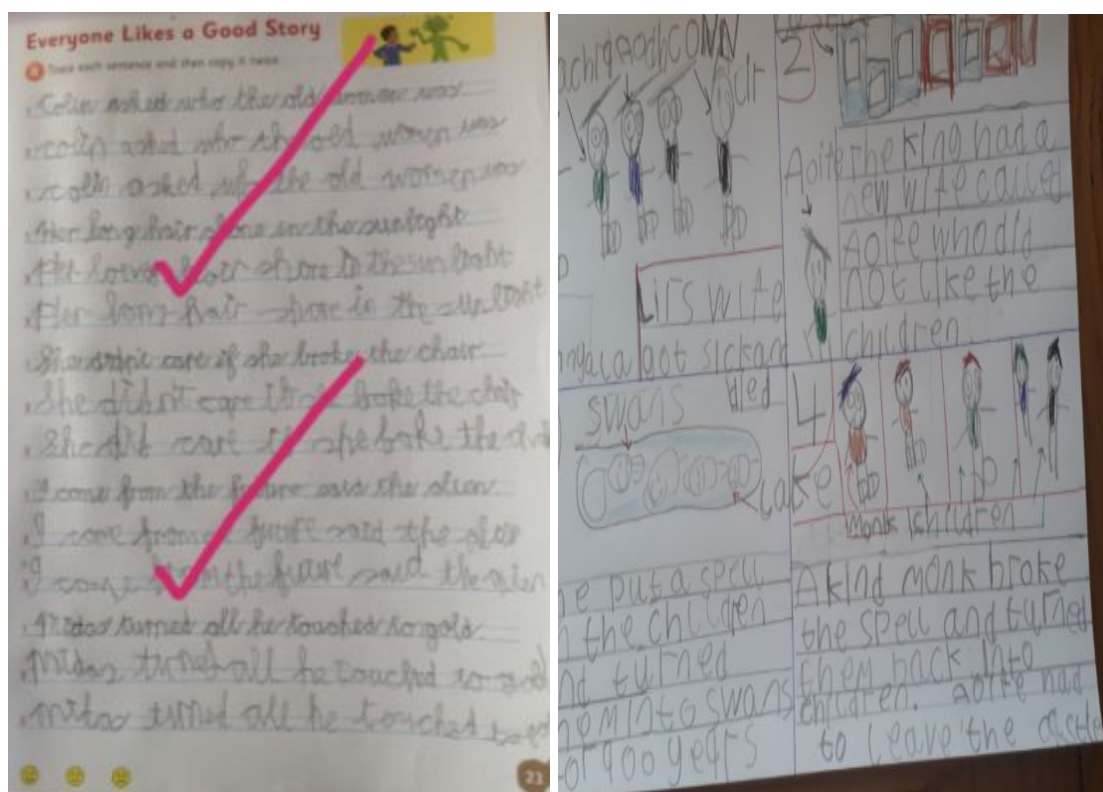
